Format: 4-person Florida Scramble, best ball

- Rules:**
1. **USGA rules will govern play with the local rules as listed on the scorecard. The 14 club rule has been waived.**
 2. **All men will tee off from the white tees; women from the red tees.**
 3. **Every player hits from the tee; then the team will hit from the most advantageous shot.**
 4. **Mulligans are to be purchased for \$10.00 each (two per player) at time of sign-in and may be used one per side.**
 5. **Ball may be moved within one club length except around green (one club head length). No position improvement allowed. If you are behind a tree, you must remain behind the tree.**
 6. **The first player "IN THE LEATHER" should pick the ball up. If is not necessary for all players to "PUTT OUT". This will speed up play. Also, in an attempt to speed up play, remember BOGEY is your friend! If you see that you are going to make more than a par, just pick up, put bogey score on that hole, and move on to the next hole.**
 7. **In case of a tie, a scorecard playoff will determine the winner, beginning with the #1 handicap hole.**
 8. **The "LONGEST DRIVE" hole (male and female) and selected Par 3 "CLOSEST TOTHE PIN" holes have signs on them. There are prizes for winners of these as well as for the putting contest.**
 9. **There will be trophies and prizes awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place teams.**
 10. **Various other prizes will be awarded so keep your mulligan ticket stubs!**

Please show respect for our host, Quail Valley Country Club, by taking care of the golf course (fix divots, etc.) and abiding by the following dress code:

**No blue jeans, no denim shorts/cutoffs/pants.
All shorts must have a minimum length of 3" above the knee.
Men must wear collared shirts.**
